BUFFALO (BRZ) sat just off of the pace and unloaded a strong response within the final furlong. FAVORITE PATRIOT had a clear lead but was unable to hold off foe. SWITCHING TO GLIDE was well off the pace early on, angled out in the stretch and had a strong late gain. ESTRICKATOR was fractious in the gate, chased the pace on the inside and weakened down the lane. IS NOT was in no rush early on but had to go five wide into the stretch and responded gamely down the lane. ONE DIEGO bore out at the start and was placed towards the rear, gained some position on the turn while going four wide but was outrun. ROYAL SHAMUS settled in the middle of the pack and showed some menace turning for home but was no match. STAND BY YOUR MAN missed the break and was well away from the rest of the field, but had a mild rally in the stretch.
