WEEKEND WEDDING was slow to settle, came well out from the rail on the turn then made up ground too late. IT IS WHAT IT IS was slow early, stayed out from the rail around the turn, came out into MUSICAL SPIN entering the stretch and lacked a closing. ISLE OF PALMA wasn't far back in the three path to the stretch then tired. LOOK WHAT I CAN DO chased early while out from the inside and stopped in the lane.
