MEGALITH dueled for the lead along the outside, took charge and drew off in the stretch while drifting out. THE CAMDEN COMET stalked the pace between horses, rallied well and had to angle in a lane at the eighth pole but did not have enough. ESTRICKATOR stalked the pace along the rail, began to lose ground on the turn but came again in the stretch. TEXAS TEX was reluctant to load, stayed off the pace and angled to the outside at the quarter pole while going five wide and hit his best stride late. BACK FORTY dueled for the lead and had a response at the top of the stretch but weakened. LEE'S SOUTH stalked the pace and lacked the needed rally. ROCKINMEBABY broke in a tangle, went four wide around the turn and was never a threat. LUCKY YEAR set the early pace but grew tired.
