BARRACUDA WAYNE tracked the pace going four wide then took control of the lead at the quarter pole with ease then was clear from there. SMOOTH SERVICE was allowed to settle early on then was forced to go five wide at the top of the stretch and closed with a rush. SIMMSTOWN settled towards the rear then was forced to go six wide turning for home and closed willingly in the stretch. BENNY TIME pushed the pace between horses and even seized the lead briefly at the three eighths pole but faded in the final furlong. WHINE FOR WINE ran towards the rear then finished evenly. MAGNA WARRIOR chased the pace on the outside going three wide around the turn but lacked the needed rally. LEFT FOOT SLEWIE was never a threat. TOWN OF TOWNS set a pressured pace and was spent in the stretch and was eased under the line.
