NEWSCAST advanced along the inside on the backstretch then tired. CALZINI ROSSI was slow leaving the gate, raced three wide around both turns and weakened. PULPIT'S PROPHECY was outrun. EASY TEN was caught wide around the first turn then was finished after a half.
