HARBOR BREEZE stalked the pace then took command of the lead in hand turning for home and won driving. SMOOTH SERVICE sat well off the pace early on but was full of run when asked for more at the three eighths pole while going four wide around the turn, finished with a good effort. STONE CRAZY was well rated early on but rallied very well along the rail in the stretch. SEAL TEAM FOUR tracked the pace setters, went three wide turning for home and finished up gamely. VAN PERSIE got jostled around a bit at the start then sat well off the pace and finished up evenly. GERMANIAC had a comfortable lead but wilted with a quarter mile to go. THUNDER LORD was well rated early on but contended around the half mile pole but grew tired and was eased.
