DIRTY DOZEN settled inside, came out nearing the stretch while moving, ran clear from the outside in early stretch and was kept to task. ALEXANDRA'S MIST was unhurried inside, was urged along after a half, came out for the drive and gained to the end. ISLAND ROMANCE wasn't far back inside, was urged to stay close, remained prominent into midstretch then weakened. MISS KRIVORUCHKA ran out while making the pace into the first turn, remained well out into the track on the backstretch, angled in to be two wide while in control entering the far turn then tired. ROLLING MO made a mild two wide run into the far turn then tired. ROO WHO was outrun. DIVINE KITTEN lagged while outrun. INVERCHAPEL briefly showed speed outside then stopped and was eased up through the final quarter.
