DAVERICK sped clear at once, stayed out from the inside and proved best under mild urging. NOW AND ZEN had early position inside, steadied in tight entering the turn, angled out three wide nearing the stretch but couldn't gain through the lane. MONTECORE showed speed between horses, angled to the rail entering the turn then weakened. PHOR PHILIPPE was slow from the gate, came well out from the inside early, moved up on the turn but lacked a strong late response. HIDDEN EXPENSE raced wide around the turn and failed to menace. A KISS IN THE PARK wasn't far back early, stayed out from the rail and tired. DAVERICK WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED LAST AS PER PENN NATIONAL RULING 11372PN.
