Footnotes

ARTILLERY EXCHANGE forced the pace three wide, gained a slim lead in the upper stretch then was all out to last. YO CAN DO pressed the issue just off the rail, missed in a determined effort. ZAVALLA DANDY forced the pace along the rail, lacked a late response. SIMPSON'S LUNCH within striking distance three wide, lacked a closing bid. DAILY EXPRESS set the pace on the rail, gave way around the turn. LEXCOAL stalked the leaders four and five wide, failed to respond. SEA HERO'S GHOST a pace factor three and four wide, lacked the needed rally. CONCERNED never threatened, four wide. FEET BE FLEET showed little along the inside. TIMETOSHUFFLEOFF stopped after a half, three wide.
