Footnotes

Z'BULLSEYE pressed the pace just off the rail, drew on even terms in the upper stretch then drew off under a drive. WONDER LITE moved up along the inside and finished willingly. YANO forced the issue four and five wide, finished well. THE REAL PRINCE set the pace under heavy pressure, weakened in the drive. TAKEN six wide down the backstretch, eased down four wide on the turn, lacked a late response. SEA DUBAI broke in a tangle, saved ground along the backstretch, angled out four wide on the turn, never threatened in the drive. LITE UP THE NITE flashed early speed five and six wide, never menaced in the stretch. DANCENSING prompted the issue three wide, steadily fell back. MAKUTUS bore out at the start, showed brief foot on the rail. The rider of SEA DUBAI claimed foul against WONDER LIFE alleging interference at the start. The Stewards reviewed the video tape replays but took no action.
