NALEE'S CROWN was unhurried, rallied the rail into the stretch and took over after a mile. MARK UP TINY wasn't far back while racing out from the rail, stayed outside the winner into midstretch then was carried out some late. DELIGHTFUL DANA settled in good position, took over two wide midway on the final turn, was clear soon after the bore out late under left hand whip and gave way. PEACHES MY DEAR was slow to settle, came well out from the rail on the final turn and finished gamely. IDLE HOUR saved ground to little avail. READ RICHIES NOTES made the early pace outside, angled to the rail on the backstretch and was finished after six furlongs. FULL QUEEN was outrun. HICKORY GRAY had early position outside then stopped and was eased up late. COMET ROAD bobbled leaving the gate then was pulled up in the stretch.
