DIAMONDSFORJEAN vied for the lead from along the inside, then drew clear on the second turn and finished under left handed urging. DELIGHTFUL DANA was never far back, raced two wide on the second turn and evenly throughout. DANCING SPARKS was close up from the start, raced along the inside through the far turn, then lacked a rally. CLASSIC JUSTICE pressed the pace from the three path through the last turn, then weakened in the stretch. SPEEDY SWEETY lacked speed, raced inside on the far turn and failed to menace. SUGAR SHARK broke in the air, raced two wide through the last turn while showing little throughout. VENUSIAN GODDESS vied for the early lead from the two path, then flattened out on the second turn.
