STICKER SHOCK was void of early speed, raced two wide on the second turn, then closed fast and drew clear under urging. WEE DAVID was slow early, raced three wide on the far turn then rallied late. EVENING CLINIC was unhurried early, raced there wide on the far turn then made a late bid. GYRFALCON (GB) pressed the pace from the two path through the far turn then weakened. MCMAZEL was close up early, raced three wide on the second turn, then lacked a late response. CAMPAIGNER failed to menace. MCMASTER vied for the early lead from the two path then faded late. SKIP N' JUMP was not a threat. ALL SOUPED UP set the pace early, was headed on the far turn then was outrun.
