BARGAIN was unhurried early, stayed out from the rail, angled out entering the stretch and gained slowly. GRADE ONE had position inside then tired. GOLDEN WAY angled to the rail on the first turn while in control then tired. SIX HITTER was outrun. FUHRY was outrun. MATTHEW LEE stopped. TALC OF DREAMS lost contact.
