FOREVER TANGO stalked the pace from the start, raced along the two path through the second turn, then drew off in the stretch and finished under urging. MARK UP TINY pressed the pace from along the inside through the far turn, angled outward in the stretch and made a late bid to be second best. GINNYGIN set the pace from the start, drew clear on the backstretch and saved ground on the far turn, then gave way late. BANKER BAILOUT was slow early, raced three wide throughout and rallied mildly in the stretch. MY WILDEST DREAMS saved ground but failed to menace. STROPPY was close up early, raced inside on the last turn, then weakened late. LETTHETIGERPARTY saved ground on the last turn and was not a threat. WILD LUNA was close up early, raced two wide on the last turn then faltered and was outrun.
