TANIS'S DIXIE TUNE was unhurried early, raced three wide on the second turn, then reached contention late and drew off under urging. CHANGING VISTA was close up from the start, saved ground and reached contention on the far turn then was outfinished. FORENSIC EDGE was slow early, raced two wide on the far turn, then found her best stride late. GINNYGIN set the pace while saving ground, was headed on the second turn then faded in the stretch. CLIFTY'S DYNAGIRL pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the last turn then faltered. LETTHETIGERPARTY lacked speed, raced three wide on the second turn and was outrun. DIAMONDSFORJEAN pressed the early pace from the inside, then flattened out on the last turn and was eased to the wire. COMET ROAD was close up early, then pulled up on the last turn and was vanned off.
