Footnotes

MISS DUCKHORN stalked the runner-up from the inside, dueled approaching the three eighths pole, reached the lead past that point, contested the advantage through the turn, bore out from the eighth pole under a right hand drive but held on well. ALL FOR BROOK was hustled briefly clear to set the pace off the rail, dueled into the turn, contested a slim disadvantage to the top of the lane, was carried out midstretch and finished evenly. I'M YOUR GAL chased the pace from the inside, eased outward through the turn then leveled off in the stretch. DESTINY ROAD, a step slow to break, chased the pace toward mid track then leveled off through the lane. MIDNIGHT SEARCH, off the pace outside, showed no response on the turn. GINNYGIN gave close chase from the four path to the five sixteenths pole before fading. SHE'SMINENOTYOURS chased the early pace from the outside then faded on the turn. BEHOLD A LADY came away sharply with a brief lead but lacked further speed while racing outside. The stewards reviewed a claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of All For Brook, then left the race as-is.
