IL DIVO stalked the pace from along the inside through the turn, then angled out in the stretch and rallied to be up in the final strides. KIERNAN'S LEGACY set the pace from the start, saved ground through the turn with a clear lead, then was outfinished in the final strides. A KISS IN THE PARK was never far back, raced along the three path on the turn then made a late bid. CHEROKEE EMPIRE was close up early, raced three wide on the turn then weakened in the stretch. NORJAC raced along the inside on the turn and failed to menace. ARE YOU SERIOUS pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then weakened late. EURO GHOST lacked speed, raced along the two path on the turn and was never a threat. KING BO BO raced along the four path on the turn while trailing the field.
