## **Footnotes**

SLY DIAMOND JIM rated back about the four path, was carried out by the loose Obi Wan through the turn, rallied widest into the lane and got up the final strides. EL CAMPO, a step slow to break, briefly settled toward the inside, closed on the rail through the turn, eased out in the upper stretch, drew aim nearing the wire and while just up for place, was outfinished for the win. KALAMAZOO rated close toward mid track, dueled to a short lead approaching the sixteenth pole but was outfinished the final strides. PATTY'S BLUFF pressured the pace two deep, contested a short lead through the turn after saving ground into the turn then dueled onto late stretch before weakening. BRING OUT THE BEST rated close three wide, gave chase through the turn then weakened in the stretch. UNCLE DIVSIE showed no early speed outside then carried extremely wide through the turn by the loose Obi Wan. MAGICAL AMERICAN rated the early pace four wide, contested the turn then gave way into the lane. OBI WAN rated in good position inside, was pinched back hitting the rail near the seven sixteenths pole and lost his rider. The stewards posted the inquiry though made no change.
