ZOSOGOOD stalked wide, took the lead and was clear lead final turn, drifted out and tired. I'M SURE saved ground and had no rally. FEARLESS COWBOY broke slowly, made a run wide but then flattened out. DAPPER DEVIL was wide and just off the pace, tired. WYNN WILLIE WYNN set the early pace out from the rail and tired badly. STRIKE DOWN was finished after a quarter mile.
