Footnotes

IRISH MAJESTY was unhurried early, rallied wide around the final turn, closed outside through the lane and took over in late stretch. MYSTIC HARBOR was unhurried inside the winner, came out on the final turn while moving, split horses through the lane and finished gamely. SLOW NICK C was never far back, moved two wide to command midway on the final turn, regained command in midstretch but faltered. MR. HENRY TWO U had good position out from the inside but lacked a rally. R J'S PROSPECT was caught in tight between rivals entering the first turn, advanced the three path around the final turn, opened a short lead into the final furlong then weakened. NICOLE'S PROSPECT cleared early, stayed inside and was finished after three-quarters. TWILIGHT BAY stopped outside. ARCATA was outrun then was eased up through the stretch. CONSTABULARY pulled up on the far turn and was vanned off.
