BILLY GILMAN was slow early, then raced three wide on the turn and closed fast while drawing off under encouragement. VICTORIOUS RECALL was never far back, raced two wide on the turn, rallied late and finished well. DEER DANNY BOY vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then weakened in deep stretch. PEN EYES vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then gave way late. POLISH JEWEL was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. HOLD HARD was three wide on the turn and failed to menace. WILLIAM'S CAT lacked speed and showed little then passed tiring rivals. JD'S MARMEL was close up early, raced inside on the turn, then lacked a late rally. DOLMEN (CHI) pressed the early pace, raced three wide on the turn then flattened out.
