MR. CARPE DIEM ran with the pace from the outset, raced wide around the turn, took over entering the final furlong and prevailed. TABICA GRILL ran inside the winner but wasn't enough. MAHICAN was unhurried while not far back, raced two wide around the turn, angled out through the lane and gained to the end. DALEWOODS PROMISE took command at once, stayed inside and gave way in the lane. HOPPIN' JOHN had position inside but no rally. RUPERT'S KENNY K lacked a rally. SIR SOCRATES went evenly. VICTORIOUS RECALL threw his head in the air while breaking poorly.
