QUICK BOOK was void of early speed, raced four wide on the turn, then rallied late and was up in the final strides. VICTORIOUS RECALL pressed the pace from along the inside through the turn, then closed ground willingly and just missed. METAL MASTER stalked the pace from the three path on the turn and finished well. ELUSIVE JORDAN prompted the pace from the two path, contended on the turn, then weakened late. CAPTAIN PHILLIP set the pace while saving ground, was headed on the turn, then tired in the drive. POLISH JEWEL raced three wide on the turn and evenly throughout. IRISH STORM saved ground. DANCIN' REALITY was through early and outrun.
