MR. GOOD STUFF stalked the pace from along the inside through the turn, contended late and prevailed. VICTORIOUS RECALL was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then rallied late and just missed. METAL MASTER set the pace with a clear lead through the turn, then gave way in the stretch. WITH ASSURANCE saved ground and made a mild bid. POLISH JEWEL pressed the pace from the three path into the turn then faded. IRISH STORM trailed the field. COMINGUPFORAIR was close up early, then broke down and was humanely destroyed.
