Footnotes

TWICE WILD stayed out from the rail while in control and held under urging. HERLUF was never far back inside, moved to vie into the stretch but wasn't enough. ZERO MANNERS fell far back after a slow break, stayed along the rail around the turn and into midstretch then angled out late while closing fastest. B. MURRAY wasn't far back, came out three wide between horses nearing the stretch and flattened out. ROVE'S BOY pressed from the three path and weakened. SUNSHINE PLATINUM was unhurried early, came out five wide midway on the turn while moving then flattened out. WALTZ TO THE BLUES was caught wide while in good early position then tired. DIAMOND ACCOUNT was no factor.
