WASHINGTON SQUARE cleared after the break then angled to the inside and drifted late under urging. WEST LIDO was caught in tight along the rail nearing the end of the backstretch, angled out on the final turn, swung widest into the stretch and finished with good energy. RIP RAP was unhurried, made a strong three wide run on the final turn to reach contention then flattened out. RAWLEY angled to the inside while not far back and came up empty. EL CHILE DOG was content to fall far back early then angled out through the lane with a late run. MONEY ISSUES wasn't far back to the far turn then tired. SWINGER stayed out from the rail while chasing the winner early then stopped.
