WYNN WILLIE WYNN pressed the early pace, saved ground on the last turn, then lacked a late response. SATELLITE BEACH was close up early, raced three wide on the far turn, then failed to sustain that early bid. MEDAGLIA'S IMAGE raced two wide on the second turn and failed to menace. ASK OMMADON raced three wide on the second turn and trailed throughout.
