VILLAGE ROMEO stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, reached contention in mid stretch then prevailed at the wire. BRAULIO was never far back, raced inside on the turn then closed ground fast and just missed. RED PETE vied for the lead from the break, raced along the inside through the turn, then gave way late. TRADE SECRET was slow early, raced three wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. TAPIS MAGIQUE vied for the lead early, raced two wide on the turn, then faded in the stretch. TOO TOUGH PETE vied for the early lead, raced three wide through the turn, then faltered late. RUN WITH ME raced along the four path on the turn while trailing the field.
