ROCKFIELD stalked the pace from the start, raced along the two path on the far turn then angled to the outside, rallied late and drew off while under urging. MISSION GAP vied for the lead from the two path through the second turn, was entered in a long drive then was outfinished in the final yards. BACKDOOR STRIKE set the early pace, was headed on the backstretch then raced along the inside through the far turn and gave way late. SANDAZAR was close up early, raced two wide on the far turn, then lacked a rally in the drive. COUNT TO SEVEN was also close up early, raced inside on the second turn and was not a threat. WILDLEE CERTAIN pressed the early pace, raced three wide on the last turn then faded. PORTLAND POINT lacked speed, raced along the three path on the second turn and was never a factor. BEATNIK also lacked speed, raced inside on the far turn and was outrun.
