TAR BEACH vied for the lead from the start, raced between horses through the last turn and was engaged in a long drive then drew off under urging. KAFWAIN WEDGEHEART vied for the lead from along the inside through the far turn, dueled late then gave way. MYSTIC HARBOR pressed the pace from the two wide through the second turn, then rallied mildly in the stretch. BIRD'S I D was slow early, raced along the two path through the last turn, then found his best stride late. UNCLE CALVIN was close up early, raced along the inside on the far turn, then lacked a late response. CANAL STREET vied for the lead from the three path through the second turn, then faded late. MAINE INGREDIENT lacked speed, raced along the three path on the far turn and showed little throughout. BONA FIDE (ARG) prompted the early pace, raced along the two path on the second turn and was outrun.
