CAPE FINISTERRE was close up and along the three path through the turn the moved to the outside of rivals, rallied in the stretch and prevailed at the wire. UNCLE CARM was never far back, raced along the two path on the turn then angled outward and challenged the winner late just missing. CUVEE AVENUE stumbled at the start, then stalked the pace after recovering and reached contention on the turn, drew off to gain a late lead then tired from earlier efforts. VAN PERSIE was slow early, saved ground on the turn, then found his best stride late. TUXEDO RAY pressed the pace from the two path, reached contention on the turn, then weakened in the drive. STAR OF MAGIC set the early pace with a clear lead, was headed on the turn while along the inside, then faltered in the drive.
