GOOD SONG stalked in the three path, opened a clear lead in early stretch and held under urging. TWENTY BLACK was slow from the gate then moved up between rivals, was caught in tight nearing and into the turn, raced two wide into the stretch and gained mildly. WILD KAY was in command shortly after the break, stayed out from the inside while making the way to the stretch then weakened. SCARLET O'CASHY wasn't far back outside on the backstretch, stayed well out from the rail around the turn and weakened. SEVEN DEADLY SINS wasn't far back between rivals on the backstretch, was caught in tight nearing the turn then stopped. UH OH TRAFFIC had early position along the rail then stopped in the lane.
