TODAY'S MAN rated in range while saving some ground, eased out and was sent up between runners leaving the half mile marker, quickly moved up and engaged FEISTY ALBERT leaving the far turn, poked a head in front approaching the stretch, kicked clear in upper stretch, drifted in towards the rail, kept on under constant rousing and held sway. FEISTY ALBERT , with the pace four deep around the first turn, asserted himself and went clear entering the backstretch, dropped in to set the pace, met the bid of the winner near the three eighths pole, battled with that one past the five sixteenths, altered out in mid stretch and came back gamely. GRACED , away in good order, was content to stalk the pace while saving ground, angled out after six furlongs, chased the top pair into the lane but could not muster up a solid late response. VERY LUCKY stalked the early pace between runners, circled four wide under a drive into the lane, angled in a bit leaving the eighth pole and stayed willingly. MR. ROESSINK lagged off the pace, saved ground into the lane and failed to menace. HOW ABOUT PEACE was rated back from between rivals near the seven eighths pole, angled in nearing the far turn and weakened. SENOR QUICKIE stalked the pace four wide for five furlongs and faltered.
