DRAYTON HALL settled early, began a run three wide into the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch then ran clear from the outside in deep stretch under mild urging. CAMPTON moved to press two wide under rating, drew out in early stretch then was little match late. CAPTAIN SPITLER was rated three wide in good position but came up empty. PARABOLA moved clear on the first turn, remained prominent under urging along the rail into the stretch then tired. BLACK CHEVRON settled two wide and lacked a strong closing. MILES LONG GONE lagged early and failed to menace. HOV LANE stayed along the rail and weakened. TULLEY was outrun.
