RIGHT ON COURSE stalked the pace between horses, lost ground in the stretch but came again. FAVORITE PATRIOT set a pressured pace but was able to shake clear in the stretch but was outfinished late. SILVERTONGUEDTOMMY was allowed to settle early on but rallied very well in the stretch, began to drift out late and did not have enough. ZURI MWANA stumbled at the start then settled well off the pace and was able to uncork a rally. ONE DIEGO stalked the pace on the outside, went three wide turning for home then faltered. NIMBLE NEHEMIAH lacked the needed rally. DROGO was void of early speed early on but did have a mild gain. JUST ASK ROBERT hit the gate but recovered to chase the pace then folded up.
