GAMBLIN JACK stalked the pace on the inside, moved out a few paths and dug in when asked for more in the stretch, was all out under the line. FAVORITE PATRIOT had the clear early lead and even shook away from foes in the stretch but flattened out with a furlong to go. TWO MORE JACS stalked the pace on the outside going three wide, was unable to match stride with the winner but still had a good effort. APPROXIMATOR chased the pace between horses, lost action after running up on TWO MORE JACS on the turn but recovered quickly and had a mild rally in the stretch. ZA WOODMAN dropped back early on as a flight of horses was getting right, angled to the outside going around the turn in the five path then had a late gain. MEDALLICIOUS was slow into stride trailing the field then had a belated rally in the stretch. INCOMPREHENSIBLE was fractious in the gate then passed tired rivals. SILVERTONGUEDTOMMY chased the pace on the outside going around the turn in the four path then lacked the needed rally. BRITESUNNYSKY chased the pace between horses but was no threat. MARCHOSO was fractious in the gate then got up to chase the pace, lost action turning for home and was taken up and in the process of slowing down and moving off the rail he clipped heels and then lost even more ground, from then on he was under a hold through the finish. STEWARDS POSTED THE INQUIRY SIGN FOR BOTH MARCHOSO AND APPROXIMATOR LOSING STRIDE BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
