SIR CELTIC EXPRESS showed speed outside, edged clear two wide before a half, remained clear into deep stretch then held. A LIL MORE A J was unhurried between horses after a slow break then finished fast on the outside to close a gap in the final yards. ONE DIEGO wasn't far back early, angled out three wide on the turn but couldn't gain. DIXIE'S LAST LAUGH wasn't far back early, steadied behind the leaders into the turn, tried to angle out for room in early stretch then came up empty once clear. R K'S BOBKAT fell back leaving the gate, angled to the rail on the turn then made up ground too late. NOSE JOB was wide and outrun. NAVY CROSS made the early pace inside then stopped. NOTALOTATROUBLE stayed inside and failed to menace.
