Footnotes

FAVORITE PATRIOT came in on AM INSPIRED soon after the break then steadied in tight between horses soon after, angled outside, rallied three wide around the turn to vie before a half then ran clear into the stretch. DR. FUNKENSTEIN showed speed two wide but couldn't match the winner in the lane. AM INSPIRED was bumped by the winner soon after the break then was slow early, stayed along the rail around the turn and finished fast. GREEK DEFAULT moved up inside early, steadied entering the turn, came out between horses in early stretch, bumped ORIGINAL CAST and continued in hand. REASON TO DRINK was outrun three wide. TIME HAS COME lugged in leaving the gate, stayed out from the inside while making the pace into the turn then tired. ORIGINAL CAST moved up between horses early, stayed out from the rail around the turn and was bumped soundly in midstretch.
