JUBILANT VISION advanced outside early while in hand, raced the three path around the turn, rallied to the front from the outside inside the final sixteenth and drove clear late. AVIE angled out while moving to vie outside the early leader on the backstretch, opened a short lead two wide before a half, drew clear in early stretch then gave way. LA GREY ZULIANA was taken in hand early, raced two wide around the turn then finished gamely outside. PAMPAS ANGEL stayed inside and lacked a closing response. IN HASTE was close up between rivals early then tired. DELIGHTFUL LIZ opened a clear lead before going a furlong, angled to the inside and faded between rivals through the lane.
