LONG MAY YOU RUN pushed the pace then assumed command at the quarter pole and drew off from there. NEBIKON settled off the pace and was forced to take the six path turning for home, got bumped around the eighth pole in the stretch but pressed on to finish gamely. BUFFALO (BRZ) settled off the pace and was forced to enter the stretch in the five path, got in tight at the eighth pole as MEGALITH drifted out, recovered quickly and got up to just miss place. SILENT RULER lunged at the start and was void of early speed then closed willingly in the stretch. KOHL set a pressured pace then weakened in the stretch. CUMBERLAND GAP was never a threat. MEGALITH chased the pace then had no response at the quarter pole, drifted out with a furlong to go bumping with BUFFALO.
