**Footnotes**

PEA SHOOTER PRO settled well off the leaders but picked up the pace at the three eighths pole circling the field in the five path, closed with big strides in the stretch but drifted in causing TALE OF E DUBAI to check and kept drifting in bumping with EDZACTLY just before the wire. EDZACTLY dueled for the lead on the inside but dug in when asked for more fighting back to an outside challenge, bore out suddenly when rider switched to the left handed whip, caused TALE OF E DUBAI to check and bumped with PEA SHOOTER PRO just before the wire. TALE OF E DUBAI chased the pace early on but vied for the lead at the top of the stretch but was forced to check when PEA SHOOTER PRO drifted in and EDZACTLY bore out and had no time to recover. GRAVES ISLAND was allowed to settle early on and at the three eighths pole drifted in a bit, stayed towards the back but had a strong late rally along the rail. EARLY ONE MORNING chased the pace and ran gamely when asked for more but was no match. TUG OF WAR settled towards the rear but closed willingly in the stretch after going around the turn four wide. BENNY TIME vied for the lead between horses, went three wide around the turn then flattened out. BARRACUDA WAYNE hit the gate at the break then settled in the middle of the pack, got taken up when his hole closed at the three eighths pole then had no response from there. KAY'S FINESSE was never a threat. CALADBOLG was used up early. MY COWBOY stumbled at the start then trailed the whole way. THERE WERE TWO CLAIMS OF FOUL. RIDER OF BARRACUDA WAYNE CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST GRAVES ISLAND FOR INTERFERENCE AT THE THREE EIGHTHS POLE. THE OTHER WAS RIDER OF TALE OF E DUBAI CLAIMING FOUL AGAINST BOTH PEA SHOOTER PRO AND EDZACTLY FOR INTERFERENCE LATE IN THE STRETCH. BOTH WERE DISALLOWED.
