CALZINI ROSSI dueled for the lead along the outside and drew off in the stretch. BOB'S MY UNCLE stalked the pace on the outside, ran gamely in the stretch but was no match for the winner. AISLE RING chased the pace and made a bid at the three eighths pole in the five path, found a second wind inside the final furlong but did not have enough. TOWN CALLED MALICE stalked the pace between horses and ran very gamely on the rail down the stretch but was outfinished late. PAPAMAC dueled for the lead along the inside and grew tired down the lane. PERFECT SUNRISE stalked the pace along the inside and was through after half a mile. BOLD HERO was void of early speed and passed tiring rivals. PECO TRAIN showed little. NEWSCAST stumbled at the start and was no factor.
