WHATTODO WHATTODO was content to lag, circled the final turn, opened a short lead in early stretch, held on into the final strides then gave way. NEWSCAST was slow from the gate, advanced outside on the backstretch, moved four wide to a clear lead midway on the final turn then gave way in the lane. SMOKIN OPAL trailed early then passed tired ones. BALLYBRIT made the pace along the rail into the far turn then stopped. OH BILLY BILLY moved up between horses on the backstretch, vied three wide into the far turn then stopped. BURNING POINT raced two wide between horses with the pace to the far turn then stopped.
