DENALI PASS stumbled at the start but recovered quickly take the lead, stayed at the front the whole way holding off foes in the stretch while drifting out. TOWN CALLED MALICE tracked the pace setters and was not asked for run until the three eighths and responded well, took most of the turn in the five path and finished gamely. SUNNY MILLS settled in the middle of the pack and finished with a good effort. AISLE RING was allowed to settle early on but crept up into contention at the half mile pole along the rail, failed to sustain his bid. OFFICER FRED was void of early speed, stayed at the back then entered the stretch going wide, closed well but it was not enough. PECO TRAIN stalked the pace early on then dropped back a bit after half a mile then lacked the needed rally in the stretch. SMOKIN OPAL was jostled a few jumped out of the gate and had to be taken back, maintained position and finished evenly. GREAT LITE failed to menace. NEWSCAST bore out at the break but got up to chase the pace, weakened turning for home and was eased in the final furlong.
