GRANDPA'S KING was allowed to settle well off the leaders, got into stride at the top of the stretch and closed with a rush to get up in time. HECTORS PRIDE was reluctant to load then broke very well and was quick into stride, was taken back to track the pace, went three wide around the turn and began to edge away from rivals but got sniped by the closer. NORTHERN CALL ducked in at the start bumping with QUALITY INVESTMENT, rated off the pace then went four wide turning for home when he uncorked a strong rally. REEVES HILL ran well off the leaders then had a strong late rally but it was not enough. NIN'S THERMOMETER was hustled out of the gate to take the lead, held it comfortably into the stretch then buckled when collared. QUALITY INVESTMENT was reluctant to load taking a few minutes to get into the gate, then got bumped at the start by NORTHERN CALL but was unfazed and went up to chase the leader on the outside, turned for home going three wide then retreated. AYYOH tracked the pace on the inside then lacked the needed rally. FLAGNDINI was no factor. METTLER trailed.
