**Footnotes**

LIFES REWARD ran towards the rear most of the way, took the four path turning for home but swung wide at the top of the stretch looking for running room, closed willingly and edged clear. DEMOGRAPHIC TREND went three or four wide around the turns while stalking the pace on the outside, dug in when asked and finished with a good effort. ROCKET SIXTYSIX was fractious in the gate then broke well to get into stride quickly and take the lead, held it most of the way and was all out through the finish. INDIAN RED was allowed to settle not far off the pace, swung wide at the top of the stretch and rallied well. NIN'S THERMOMETER went three wide around the first turn while chasing the pace then lacked a rally when asked. LAVA was fractious in the gate, went three wide around the first turn while running towards the rear, passed tired rivals down the stretch. HEADY CREEK was in contention early on while sitting on the rail then had no rally. MEDALLICIOUS was anxious in the gate then showed little. STRONG SHAFT was fractious in the gate then broke well to chase the pace, vied for the lead briefly then surrendered. MONEYINYOUR POCKET bore out at the start hitting the gate, went around the first turn in the five path then had no response when asked.
