HONOR ACHIEVED chased the pace setter and had a game finish on the rail. BUILT IN A DAY was allowed to settle in the early going and had a mild response in the stretch. SOUERTIME was slow out of the gate and was in no rush early on, but was able to pass a tiring rival in the stretch. ANITA MARIE chased the pace setter and showed brief foot at the quarter pole but weakened. COTTON PICKIN was outrun.
