Footnotes

SMOOTH SERVICE was unhurried early, began a run after a half, rallied two wide between horses on the final turn, angled three wide into the stretch, took over before seven furlongs and drove clear. TOP PROSPECT settled, made a run four wide outside the winner around the final turn but couldn't keep up through the lane. TWIN ENGINE stayed inside while not far back, was sent closer on the final turn then flattened out in the lane. ENGLISH MANOR broke slowly, was slow early then passed tired ones. KEEPMEINSTITCHES stayed out from the inside while making the early pace, brushed with NIN'S THERMOMETER down the backstretch, opened a clear lead midway on the final turn then tired in the lane. KEY TO A CURE was outrun inside. NIN'S THERMOMETER dueled outside the early leader, came in and brushed with that one down the backstretch, stopped after three quarters and was eased up through the lane.
