Footnotes

AWESOME DANCER lead from the start and drew off in the stretch. SEARCH WARRANT chased the pace on the outside taking the turn four wide, ran gamely in the stretch but was second best. TITLE FIGHT was fractious in the starting gate but still broke well, tracked the pace setters and was forced to go around the turn four wide and had a rally in the stretch. BOOKMAKER chased the pace on the inside, stayed in contention but weakened down the lane. JUMPIN JULIAN settled towards the rear and began to gain late in the stretch but was no match. DANDELION WINE settled towards the rear and passed tired rivals. ROYAL GEORGE chased the pace between horses and got in tight just before the three eighths pole, weakened down the stretch. ADMIRAL GIANNI broke in a tangle but recovered to get up to chase the pace between horses, faded around the turn and finished on the wrong lead.
